Why do we process personal data?

When can we process your personal data?

- If this is required for the execution of our contract with you.
- If permitted as part of our business activities. In this case we will, of course, take your interests into account.
- If this is required to comply with legal obligations that apply to us.
- If you have explicitly given us permission for specifically named purposes.



How long do we retain your personal data?

- During the legal storage periods that apply to us.
- As long as we need to do so, at least during the term of our relationship or contract. We shall adhere to the maximum legal retention period.



What are your rights for the processing of your data?

- Information concerning whether we process your data
- Amending the data
- Gaining access to your data
- Limiting use of your data
- Objecting to the use of your data
- Clearing your data
- Transferring your data

How do we protect your personal data?

We ensure all appropriate technical and organisational security measures are in place. There is an obligation to report data leaks. Incidents are registered and reported if necessary.
